- HCE shall preferably handover Bio-medical wastes such as pleural fluid, ascetic fluid, HBsAG positive blood, placenta etc. to the Pharmaceutical industry / Biotechnology firms for production of drugs, reagent chemicals, markers etc. if any such as Pharmaceutical industry / Biotechnology firm approaches them for the same. If there are any difficulties in the matter, the same may be communicated to such firm and copied to the board also.
- HCE shall strictly follow the procedure for packaging & transportation of Bio-medical Wastes such as pleural fluid, ascetic fluid, HBsAG positive blood, placenta etc. to the Pharmaceutical industry / Biotechnology firms as per the guidelines of CPCB published in Feb-2019 for "Handling of BMW for utilization".
- HCEs shall submit the report to the Board office about type, quantity and frequency of handling over such BMW on yearly basis.

  5. In case of any technical difficulty towards handing over the required BMW, you shall inform to the Board accordingly.
  6. HCEs shall properly dispose and handover the waste to authorised user / facilities having valid consent to operate from MPCB.
10. This consent is issued subject to conditions mentioned below:
- a. The "authorized Person" shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the Rules made there under.
  - b. Any unauthorized change in equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this Authorization.
  - c. You shall submit details of Management and Handling of outdated, discarded, unused Cytotoxic drugs generated in the Cancer centers, research and health care in the format prescribed by CPCB which is available on www.cpcb.nic.in alongwith Annual Report to MPCB with a copy to CPCB before 31st January every year.
  - d. You shall manage the Mercury Waste in the HCE in environmentally sound manner (including storage, spilled collection, transportation and disposal) as per CPCB guidelines published on CPCB website www.cpcb.nic.in dated 07.09.2010 as detailed in document entitled "Environmentally Sound Management of Mercury Waste in Health Care Facilities".
  - e. You shall ensure phase out of chlorinated plastic bags, gloves and blood bags by HCEs within two years.
  - f. You shall establish Bar code system within one year.
  - g. You shall ensure that the liquid waste is treated and disposed by all the occupier or operator of a CBWTF in accordance with the Water Act, 1974.
  - h. You shall maintain day to day basis and display the monthly record including Annual report on its website within two years from the date of Notification.
  - i. You shall submit separate Bank Guarantees towards compliance of condition mentioned at Annexure - IV to Regional Office, within 30 days.
  - j. You shall submit compliance of Bank Guarantee conditions every six months to Regional Officer, for verification purpose.
  - k. You shall submit application for renewal of Combined Consent and Biomedical Waste authorization before 120 days along with appropriate fees.







Terms & conditions for compliance of Water Pollution Control:

1. A) As per your application, you have provided Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) of designed capacity of 10.00 CMD consisting of Primary (Collection tank, Neutralization tank)
- B) The Applicant shall operate the effluent treatment plant (ETP) to treat the trade effluent so as to achieve the following standards prescribed by the Board or under EP Act, 1986 and Rules made there under from time to time, whichever is stringent:

I. Compulsory Parameters	Limiting Concentration in mg/l, except for pH
(1) pH	5.5 to 8.5
(2) Oil & Grease	10 mg/l
(3) BOD (3 days 27°C)	30 mg/l
(4) Total Suspended Solids	100
(5) COD	250 mg/l

C) The treated effluent shall be recycled for secondary purposes to the maximum extent and remaining shall be discharged on land for gardening within premise and remaining shall be disposed in sewerage system provided by local body. In no case, sewage shall find its way outside hospital premises.

A) As per your application you have provided Sewage Treatment Plant of designed capacity 25 CMD for the treatment of 8 CMD of sewage.

B) The Applicant shall operate the sewage treatment system to treat the sewage so as to achieve the following standards:

1	BOD	Not to exceed	30 mg/l
2	COD	Not to exceed	100 mg/l
3	Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	50 mg/l

C) The treated sewage shall be recycled for secondary purposes to the maximum extent and remaining shall be discharged on land for gardening within premise and remaining shall be disposed in sewerage system provided by local body. In no case, sewage shall find its way outside hospital premises.

3. The Board reserves its rights to review plans, specifications or other data relating to plant setup for the treatment of waterworks for the purification thereof & the system for the disposal of sewage or trade effluent or in connection with the grant of any consent conditions. The Applicant shall obtain prior consent of the Board to take steps to establish the unit or establish any treatment and disposal system or an extension or addition thereto.
4. The industry shall ensure replacement of pollution control system or its parts after expiry of its expected life as defined by manufacturer so as to ensure the compliance of standards and safety of the operation thereof.







1. This CCA shall be in force for a period from 11-06-2021 To 10-06-2026

4. You shall not store Bio Medical waste beyond 48 hours from the generation.
5. You shall use only non-chlorinated plastic coloured bags.
6. You shall ensure use of colour coded bins and bags for segregation of BMW as required under BMW Management Rules 2016.
7. You shall not mix General/other Solid waste with Bio Medical Waste.
8. You shall ensure segregation, treatment and disposal of General / Other Municipal solid waste as per Solid Waste Management rules, 2016.
9. You shall pay the charges to authorized Common Bio Medical waste Treatment and Disposal facility for its services as agreed upon during the membership registration or as amended.
10. You shall comply and strictly abide with the conditions stipulated in BMW Management Rules, 2016 as amended time to time.
11. You shall handover Plastic / Metal waste (BMW) to Common Bio medical waste treatment and Disposal facility allocated to you for treatment & disposal or plastic/metal recycler authorized by MPCB for BMW Handling and maintain records thereof & submit to MPCB in Annual report.
12. You shall provide training to all workers involved in handling of bio-medical waste at the time of induction and at least once a year thereafter and maintain record thereof.
13. You shall undertake appropriate medical examination of all BMW Waste handlers & staff at the time of induction and at least once in a year and immunize all involved in management of Bio Medical Waste for protection against diseases, including Hepatitis B and Tetanus, that are likely to be transmitted while handling bio medical waste and maintain the records for the same.
14. You shall ensure use of personal protective Equipment such as Heavy Duty Gloves (Workman's Gloves), Gum Boots or safety shoes for waste collectors, Face mask, Head Cap, Splash Proof Gowns or aprons etc., Disposal gloves by waste handlers.
15. You shall develop and operate own website. The website should be uploaded on monthly basis with all the information relating to Bio-Medical waste management including this CCA and other permission and report.
16. You shall maintain all record for Generation, for a period of five years and produce whenever asked by MPCB authorities.
17. The occupier and operator of a Health Care Establishment shall be liable for all the damages caused to the environment or the public due to improper handling of bio-medical wastes.
18. You shall ensure submission of Annual Report of BMW for the period Jan to Dec, including category and quantity of BMW Generated and Disposed in Form IV for preceding year before 30th June of every year to the Regional Office, MPCB, Nagpur and uploading the same to MPCB Portal (<https://www.ecmpcb.in/>).
19. You are responsible to submit application for renewal of Combined Consent & Biomedical Waste authorization before 120 days of expiry.





**SCHEDULE-IV**

**General Conditions**

The following general conditions shall apply:-

1. You shall provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
2. Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or event, such emissions occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith reported to Board, concerned Police Station, Executive Engineer MIDC and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipments, the process connected to it shall be stopped.
3. You shall provide an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the applicant shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control operation to abide by terms and conditions of this consent.
4. You shall submit to this office, the 30th day of September every year, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 15 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992.
5. You shall comply with the Hazardous Waste (M, H & TM) Rules, 2016 and submit the Annual Returns as per Rule 20(2) of Hazardous Waste (M, H & TM) Rules, 2016 for the preceding year April to March in Form-IV by 30th June of every year to Regional Office, Nagpur.
6. You shall engage qualified staff/personnel/agency to see the day to day compliance of consent & authorization condition towards Environment Protection.
7. Separate drainage system shall be provided for collection of trade and sewage effluents. Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of the collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No effluent shall be admitted in the pipes/sewers downstream of the Terminal manholes. No effluent shall find its way other than in designed and provided collection system.
8. Neither storm water nor discharge from other premises shall be allowed to mix with the effluents from the HCE.
9. You shall install a separate meter showing the consumption of energy for operation of domestic and industrial effluent treatment plants and air pollution control system. A register showing consumption of chemicals used for treatment shall be maintained.
10. You should not cause any nuisance in surrounding area. You shall maintain good housekeeping.
11. You shall bring minimum 33% of the available open land under green coverage/ plantation. The applicant shall submit a yearly statement by 30th September every year on available open plot area, number of trees surviving as on 31st March of the year and number of trees planted.
12. The non-hazardous solid waste arising in the HCE premises, sweepings, etc. be disposed of scientifically so as not to cause any nuisance / pollution. The applicant shall take necessary permissions from civic authorities for disposal of solid waste.

General Conditions

The following general conditions shall apply as per the type of the industry

- 1) You shall provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
- 2) You should monitor effluent quality, stack emissions, noise and ambient air quality quarterly.
- 3) You shall provide ports in the chimney/(s) and facilities such as ladder, platform etc. for monitoring the air emissions and the same shall be open for inspection to/and for use of the Board's Staff. The chimney(s) vents attached to various sources of emission shall be designated by numbers such as S-1, S-2, etc. and these shall be painted/ displayed to facilitate identification.
- 4) Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or even such emissions occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith Reported to Board, concerned Police Station, office of Directorate of Health Services, Department of Explosives, Inspectorate of Factories and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipments, the production process connected to it shall be stopped.
- 5) You shall provide an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the applicant shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control production to abide by terms and conditions of this consent.
- 6) You shall submit, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992 to Regional Office, Nagpur, the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September every year.

- 9) An inspection book shall be opened and made available to the Board's officers during their visit to the HCE.

- 12) Separate drainage system shall be provided for collection of trade and sewage effluents. Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of the collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No effluent shall be admitted in the pipes/sewers downstream of the terminal manholes. No effluent shall find its way other than in designed and provided collection system.
- 13) Neither storm water nor discharge from other premises shall be allowed to mix with the effluents from the HCE.

- 16) You shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standard in respect of noise to less than 75 dB (A) during day time and 70 dB (A) during night time. Day time is reckoned in between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- 17) You shall maintain good housekeeping.
- 18) You shall bring minimum 33% of the available open land under green coverage/ plantation. The applicant shall submit a yearly statement to Regional Office, Nagpur by 30th September every year on available open plot area, number of trees surviving as on 31<sup>st</sup> March of the year and number of trees planted by September end.
- 19) The non-hazardous solid waste arising in the factory premises, sweepings, etc. be disposed of scientifically so as not to cause any nuisance / pollution. The applicant shall take necessary permissions from civic authorities for disposal of solid waste.
- 20) You shall not change or alter the quantity, quality, the rate of discharge, temperature or the mode of the effluent/emissions or hazardous wastes or control equipments provided for without previous written permission of the Board. - 24) You shall observe provisions of E-waste (Management and Handling) Rules 2011 and Battery Waste (Management and Handling) Rules 2001, as amended.

You shall observe following fuel pattern attached herewith.

2. The Applicant shall obtain prior permission of WPC Board for providing additional control equipment with necessary specification and installed thereof or replacement/alteration well before start of work on new or existing control equipment.

3. The Board reserves its rights to suspend or stop the operation of the D.G. Set in any technical or important matter or to require the applicant to provide additional control equipment either in whole or in part.

4. Conditions for D.G. Set:

a. Noise from the D.G. Set should be controlled by installing a soundproof enclosure treating the room acoustically by soundproofing.

b. Acoustic enclosure/noise treatment of the room should be done in a manner as per the provision for meeting the ambient noise level as per the standards provided. A suitable exhaust system with necessary filters should be provided. The measurement of noise level should be done at a distance of 10 meters from acoustic enclosure and this should be recorded.

The chimney(s) vents attached to various sources of emission shall be designated by numbers such as S-1, S-2, etc. and these shall be painted/displayed to facilitate identification.
4. Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or even, such emissions occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith Reported to Board, concerned Police Station, office of Directorate of Health Services, Department of Explosives, Inspectorate of Factories and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipments, the production process connected to it shall be stopped.
5. You shall provide an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the applicant shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control production to abide by terms and conditions of this consent.
6. You shall submit, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992 to Regional Office, the 30th day of September every year.
7. You shall recycle/reprocess/reuse/recover Hazardous Waste as per the provision contain in the HW (MH&TM) Rules 2008, which can be recycled /processed /reused /recovered and only waste which has to be incinerated shall go to incineration and waste which can be used for land filling and cannot be recycled/reprocessed etc should go for that purpose, in order to reduce load on incineration and landfill site/environment.
8. You shall comply with the Hazardous Waste (M, H & TM) Rules, 2008 and submit the Annual Returns to RO- as per Rule 5(6) & 22(2) of Hazardous Waste (M, H & TM) Rules, 2008 for the preceding year April to March in Form-IV by 30th June of every year.
9. An inspection book shall be opened and made available to the Board's officers during their visit to the HCE.

- (i) BMW shall not be mixed with other wastes or reused, recycled or sold in any form.
- (ii) BMW shall be segregated into containers / bags at the point of generation in accordance with Schedule-I prior to storage, treatment and disposal. The containers shall be labeled according to Schedule IV- Part-A.
- (iii) If a container containing BMW is to be transported from the premises where BMW is generated to any waste treatment facility outside the premises, the container shall, apart from the Label prescribed in Schedule IX, also carry information prescribed in Schedule IV Part B and shall be transported by authorized Transporter only.
- (iv) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 or Rules there under, BMW shall be transported only in such vehicle as may be authorized for the purpose by the competent authority as specified by the Government.
- (v) Untreated human anatomical waste, animal anatomical waste, soiled waste and, biotechnology waste shall not be stored beyond a period of forty- eight hours.


Provided that in case for any reason it becomes necessary to store such waste beyond such a period, the occupier shall take appropriate measures to ensure that the waste does not adversely affect human health and the environment and inform the prescribed authority along with the reasons for doing so.

- (vi) Microbiology waste and all other clinical laboratory waste shall be pre-treated by sterilisation to Log 6 or disinfection to Log 4, as per the World Health Organisation guidelines before packing and sending to the common bio-medical waste treatment facility.

#### 10. Standards for waste autoclaving:

The autoclave should be dedicated for the purposes of disinfecting and treating bio-medical waste,

- (i) When operating a gravity flow autoclave, medical waste shall be subjected to:
  - (i) a temperature of not less than 121 C° and pressure of 15 pounds per Square inch (psi) for an autoclave residence time of not less than 60 minutes; or
  - (ii) a temperature of not less than 135 C° and a pressure of 31 psi for an autoclave residence time of not less than 45 minutes; or
  - (iii) a temperature of not less than 149 C° and a pressure of 52 psi for an autoclave residence time of not less than 30 minutes.
- (ii) When operating a vacuum autoclave, medical waste shall be subjected to a minimum of one pre-vacuum pulse to purge the autoclave of all air. The waste shall be subjected to the following:
  - (i) a temperature of not less than 121 C° and a pressure of 15 psi for an autoclave residence time of not less than 45 minutes; or
  - (ii) a temperature of not less than 135 C° and a pressure of 31 psi for an autoclave residence time of not less than 30 minutes; or
- (iii) Medical waste shall not be considered properly treated unless the time, temperature and pressure indicators indicate that the required time, temperature, and pressure were reached during the autoclave process. If for any reasons, time, temperature or pressure indicates that the required temperature, pressure or residence time was not reached, the entire load of medical waste must be autoclaved again until the proper temperature, pressure and residence time were achieved.



- (IV) *Recording of operational parameters*, - Each autoclave shall have graphic computer recording devices which will automatically and continuously monitor and record dates, time of day, load identification number and operational parameters throughout the entire length of the autoclave cycle.
- (V) *Validation test: Spore testing*. - The autoclave should completely consistently kill the approved biological indicator at the maximum design capacity of each autoclave unit. Biological indicator for autoclave shall be Bacillus stearothermophilus spores using vials or spore strips, with at least  $1 \times 10^4$  spores per milliliter. Under no circumstances will an autoclave have minimum operational parameters less than a residence time of 30 minutes, regardless of temperature and pressure, a temperature less than 121 C° or a pressure, less than 15 psi.
- (VI) *Routine Test*. - A chemical indicator strip/tape that changes color when a certain temperature is reached can be used to verify that a specific temperature has been achieved. It may be necessary to use more than one strip over the waste package at different locations to ensure that the inner content of the package has been adequately autoclaved.
11. Every 'Authorized Person' shall submit an Annual Report to the prescribed authority in Form-IV by 31<sup>st</sup> January every year including information about the categories and quantities of BMW handled during the preceding year.
12. (i) Every 'Authorized Person' shall maintain records related to the generation, collection, reception, storage, transportation, treatment, disposal and/or any form of handling of BMW for period of 5 years in accordance with these Rules and guidelines issued.
- (ii) All records shall be subject to inspection and verification by the prescribed authority at any time.
13. Accident reporting - 1) In case of any major accident at any institution or facility or any other site while handling bio-medical waste, the authorized person shall intimate immediately to the prescribed authority about such accident and forward a report within twenty-four hours in writing regarding the remedial steps taken in Form I.
- 2) Information regarding all other accidents and remedial steps taken shall be provided in the annual report in accordance with rule 13 by the occupier.
